HIGHLIGHTS OF THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE STEENBURG LAKE

COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION - 1971

EXPLANATION

As many campers are unable to attend business meetings at which policies are being determined, it was suggested that some notes of action taken, be summarized, in order that all might be informed. The following is a brief list of Action Items taken from the minutes:

1. That a committee, appointed by the President, will meet with the Council of Limerick Township to discuss garbage and waste disposal on August 6, 1971.
2. That the procedures for maintaining acceptable water levels in Steenburg Lake, as endorsed by the Association, be filed with the Member of Parliament of the Provincial Government, the Crowe Valley Conservation Authority, and the Township Councils. These were published in the spring newsletter. The executive have now been directed to press for implementation.
3. The Executive have been assured by the Department of Municipal Affairs of the Province of Ontario that Steenburg Lake cannot support additional sub-divisions on the property known as the Headlands.
4. While it was not part of the Annual Meeting, it is known that the Department of Health, in co-operation with the Ontario Water Resources Commission, intends to survey waste disposal facilities and water purity in 1972.
5. Because of lack of support, there will be no organized cottagers' dinner in 1971. There was regret expressed by those who attended the extremely enjoyable Pot Luck supper held last year at Bass Lake Lodge.
6. To date, for 1971, only one third of the cottagers have financially supported the Association. It is the opinion of the members present at the Annual Meeting, that the business being conducted, and the importance to the Community is sufficient, to warrant much more attention by the summer taxpayers than is presently being accorded.
7. You are being visited by a volunteer committee member who is concerned about your opinions, and for the future environment of the summer resident on Steenburg Lake.
8. Your President, completing his second year, is John Maunder, an engineer with the Ford Motor Company. Your annual dues are \$2.00.
