MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS --

As many of you may already be aware, this is election year for municipal offices. Offices which are open for election in Limerick Township are the offices of reeve, four town council offices, and school trustee. In the township of Tudor, Cashel, the offices open for election are the office of reeve, deputy reeve, three town council offices, and school trustee.

As you will notice from the information below, the length of term for municipal office has changed from two years to three years. The present reeve of Limerick Township, Clive Wilson, who attended the July Cottagers' Association meeting, mentioned that it was particularly important that cottagers participate in this election as the possibility did exist of issues arising in this three year term that would directly affect residents of Steenburg Lake.

However, an ongoing cottager complaint is "What do we get for our tax dollars". This is our chance to ask the candidates questions such as this and to tailor our votes accordingly.

ENVIRONMENTAL --

Water testing will be carried out from the 24 th of May 1983 to Labour Day 1983 with results being published in a report by Dave Langman in the Fall 1983 Newsletter.

Seasonal monitoring and adjustment of Steenburg Lake water levels are now being carried out by the Crowe Valley Conservation Authority.
