NEGOTIATIONS WITH LIMERICK COUNCIL

Discussions with Council described in the FALL portion of this letter yielded the following results:

BOAT LAUNCHING will be permitted at the PUBLIC BEACH until JUNE 15 and after OCTOBER 1 until other sites are available.

The EAST ROAD is a 33 foot seasonal road and cannot be plowed in winter unless it is ungraded to a 66 foot year round standard. Limerick and Tudor/Cashel have been plowing a parking area at the Highway entrance on an alternating basis for the last eight years.

ANNUAL MEETING

This year's Annual Meeting will be at the LIMERICK CENTRE: July 25, 7:30 p.m. The same format as last year will be used, a short business meeting followed by a wine and cheese social.

66 FOOT SHORELINE ALLOWANCE

The Provincial Government has finally released Guidelines allowing interested Municipalities to develop procedures for the sale of shoreline allowance. A photocopy of these guidelines has been attached for your information.
