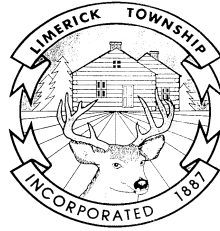

**Re: Steenburg Lake South Road Advisory Committee
Winter Maintenance Petition**

To All Concerned Parties;

The Minutes of the Steenburg Lake South Road Advisory Committee for October 22nd and October 29th, 2012 were presented to Council at the regular meeting of November 6th, 2012. In a closed session of the Council of the Township of Limerick on November 6, 2012, after discussing all of the information received, a decision by Council was made to put forth two proposals to the Steenburg Lake South Road Advisory Committee. The reason for the closed session is cited under Sections 239 (2) c & e of the Municipal Act. The following two proposals shall be the only two options considered for winter maintenance at this time;

Proposal One

The Township of Limerick agrees to provide access and winter maintenance rights to Tudor and Cashel Township, providing they meet our minimum level of service requirements. This would allow Tudor and Cashel to provide winter service to their residents using their own staff and equipment as they deem appropriate.


Such an agreement would need to be formalized and the various provisions contained within reviewed by our solicitor. East Bay Road would remain a Class 6-2 seasonally maintained road, regardless of new changes.

Proposal Two

Maintain status quo. All residents within both Municipalities on Steenburg Lake South Road will remain designated as seasonal, and no further reclassification will be needed.

Council wishes to thank all participants of the Steenburg Lake South Road Advisory Committee for time and effort put forth. While Council endeavors to assist each situation as presented, they must also be objective in their decision making by representing the interest of all taxpayers as a whole.
